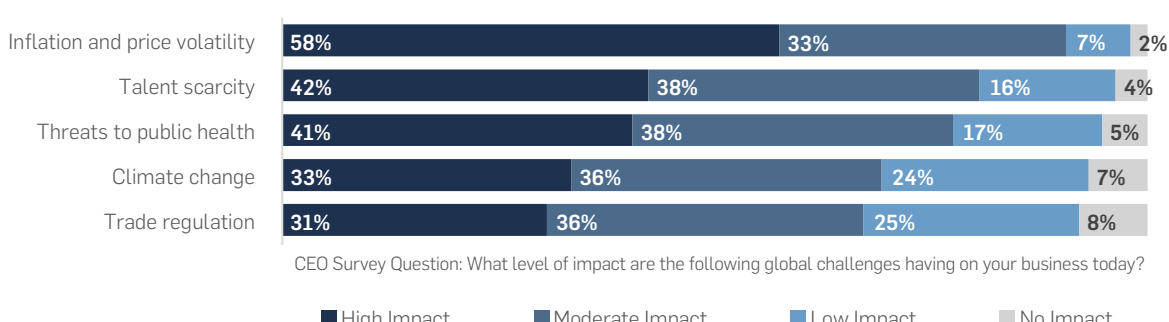
## TO BUILD RESILIENCE IN A FRACTURED WORLD, CEOs ARE EMBRACING SUSTAINABILITY
